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GENERAL INFORMATION

A. CONCURRENCE:

The Village of Angelica concurs in and agrees to abide by the rules and regulations as set forth in the generic tariff filed by the New York Municipal Power Agency (NYMPA) in Case No. 97-E-1575.

B. TERRITORY TO WHICH SCHEDULE APPLIES:

These rates, rules and regulations are applicable to the Village of Angelica.

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SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 1
Residential

APPLICABLE TO USE OF SERVICE FOR:

Single-phase residential purpose usage in an individual residence; in an individual flat or individual apartment in a multiple-family dwelling; for residential purposes in a rooming house where not more than four (4) rooms are available for rent; and for single phase farm service when supplied through the farm residence meter; use exclusively in connection with religious purposes by corporations or associations organized and conducted in good faith for religious purposes, and including the operation by such corporation or association of a school, notwithstanding that secular subjects are taught at such school; for single-phase service exclusively in connection with a community residence as defined in subdivision 28, 28A or 28B of section 1.03 of the Mental Hygiene Law, provided that such residence is operated by a not-for-profit corporation and if supervisory staff is on site on a twenty-four hour per day basis that the residence provides living accommodations for fourteen or fewer residents; and use for any post or hall owned or leased by a not-for-profit organization that is a veterans organization.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Continuous, single-phase alternating current, approximately 60 hertz,
120/240 volts, 3- wire or 120 volts, 2-wire.

The Winter Rate shall take effect beginning with the first full billing period following November First.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge is the Customer Charge.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills are due when rendered. Full payment must be received on or before the date shown on the bill to avoid a late payment charge of 1.5% as provided in Rule VIII of the NYMPA generic tariff.

PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT:

The charges set forth in this service classification shall be subject to a purchased power adjustment as explained in Rule IX of the NYMPA generic tariff.

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SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 2
 General Service - Non-demand Metered

APPLICABLE TO USE OF SERVICE FOR:

Small commercial or industrial customers whose monthly Kilowatt-hour consumption does not exceed 6,000 kilowatt-hours in any month during the winter billing period. Customers whose monthly kilowatt-hour consumption exceeds 6,000 kilowatt-hours in any month during the winter Billing Period shall be transferred to Service Classification No.3 (for definition of winter billing period, see S.C. No. 1 residential rate). The customer may be returned to Service Classification No. 2 if after twelve months of being on Service Classification No. 3 the customer's monthly kilowatt-hour consumption does not exceed 6,000 kilowatt-hours in any month during the Winter Billing Period, and if the customer's monthly demand is less than 20 kW.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Continuous, single phase alternating current, approximately 60 hertz, 120/240 volts, or three phase, 240, 480 or 2400 watts.

Large commercial or industrial customers whose monthly demand is equal to or exceeds 20 kw during the Winter Billing Period and whose energy consumption exceeds 6,000 kWh in any Winter Billing month (for definition of winter billing period, see S.C. No. 1 residential rate).

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Continuous, single phase alternating current, approximately 60 hertz, 120/240 volts, or three phase, 240, 480 or 2400 volts.

MONTHLY RATE:

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SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 3 (CONT'D)
General Service - Demand Metered

DETERMINATION OF DEMAND:

The maximum demand used for billing shall be taken as the maximum 30-minute integrated demand occurring during the month. The maximum demand shall be measured by 30-minute kW demand meters furnished and installed by the Village of Angelica Electric Department.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge is the Demand Charge.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills are due when rendered. Full payment must be received on or before the date shown on the bill to avoid a late payment charge of 1.5% as provided in Rule VIII of the NYMPA generic tariff.

PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT:

The charges set forth in this service classification shall be subject to a purchased power adjustment as explained in Rule IX of the NYMPA generic tariff.
