- (1) Who does not take service under Service Classification No. 10,
- (2) Who adds at least 50 kW of separately metered demand to the Company's system by (a) constructing a new facility; or (b) purchasing or leasing an existing facility that has been vacant for at least six months; or (c) expanding an existing facility; or (d) adding facilities (regardless of size) through the redevelopment of a vacant or inactive site, including land or buildings, which have been previously developed, and have been vacant or inactive for at least six months, and which are proposed for reuse or redevelopment with the assistance of public financing; or (e) developing facilities or projects (regardless of size) which are located in areas eligible to receive Urban Development Action Grants, and
- (3) Whose facilities are classified by the <u>Standard Industrial Classification Manual</u> (1972 edition or supplements thereto) as (a) Commercial and Stock Savings Banks (Division H, Group No. 602) or as (b) Mutual Savings Banks (Division H, Group No. 603) or as (c) Business Credit Institutions (Division H, Industry No. 6153, credit card service, collection by central agency) or as (d) Manufacturing (Division D) or as (e) Computer and Data Processing Services (Division I, Industry No.7372 and No.7374) or as (f) Miscellaneous Business Services (Division I, Industry No.7391), except that facilities under (a), (b) and (c) shall be limited to "back-office" operations or support functions requiring no customer contact; and
