Nos. 2 and 3 having a minimum load of 250 kW and (a) is classified in Standard Industrial Classification - Major Groups 20-51 and 60-89; and (b) where certification is provided from the NY State Department of indicating the customer Economic Development (DED) satisfactorily documented that Comprehensive Tax or Economic Incentives and the Business Retention Discount are both necessary to retain the customer in New York State. To be considered for certification by DED, the customer must satisfactorily document one or more actual, impending relocation opportunities outside New York State that would significantly reduce the operating costs of the The customer must also document the existence of Comprehensive Tax or Economic Incentives from local and/or State authorities.
