rates under this Service Classification. Any growth over the base year in energy and demand will be billed at 90% of the monthly rate. A customer meeting the load growth criteria on or before April 1, 1998 will be billed at the rates specified in this special provision for a period of sixty months from the date customer meets the load growth criteria, after which the customer will be billed at full rates under this Service Classification. A customer meeting the load growth criteria after April 1, 1998 will be billed at the rates specified in this special provision until June 30, 2001, after which the customer will be billed at full rates under this Service Classification.

#### Audits

Qualifying audit recommendations that require high cost capital improvements will upon request of the customer, be evaluated on a case by case basis. The Energy Supply Charge, as defined in General Information Section 29, shall apply to electricity provided and sold by the Company under this Special Provision; however, the discount shall not apply to the Energy Supply Charge. Customers participating in the Retail Access Program as described in General Information Section 35 shall not be subject to this charge.

# Qualifying Locations

Locations which qualify for the discount will be identified by the Company and updated every six months. A list of qualifying locations will be provided to the Public Service Commission and the New York State Department of Economic Development.

Customers will not be eligible to commence taking service under this Special Provision after June 30, 2001.
