Public Fire Hydrant Service in all municipal jurisdictions within the former territory of United Water New Rochelle.

##### CHARACTER OF SERVICE: Continuous.

##### TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Bills are rendered monthly or quarterly, in arrears and are due and payable when rendered. If the bill is not paid within twenty days after presentation, service may be discontinued after proper notice as required by law.

A late payment charge to be computed at the rate of 1.5% per month, compounded monthly, may be applied to all unpaid balances no sooner than 23 days from the mailing of the bill.

Bills rendered at the above rates are subject to surcharges, surcredits and adjustment clauses as contained elsewhere in this tariff.

##### SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

1. Water may be taken from any public hydrant only by duly authorized members of the municipal fire department for the sole purpose of extinguishing fires. Water shall not be taken from any public fire hydrant, either by duly authorized members of the municipal fire department or by any other person for any purpose other than extinguishing fires, unless specifically authorized by the Company.
2. Requests for the installation of public hydrants must be made in writing by an authorized official of the municipality, specifying the exact location of the required hydrant. When a request is made by a municipality to change the location of an existing hydrant, the entire cost of the work must be borne by the municipality requesting the change.
