Dear Secretary Burgess:

In compliance with *Order Establishing Community Choice Data Access Fees*, issued and effective on December 14, 2017 (“CCA Fee Order”) in Case Nos. 17-M-0315, 16-M-0411 and 14-M-0224, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“Distribution” or the “Company”) submits tariff amendments for its tariff, P.S.C. No. 9 – GAS, to become effective on January 6, 2018 as follows:

Statement of Community Choice Aggregation – CCA-1

These proposed tariff amendments as submitted in compliance with Ordering Clause 2 of CCA Fee Order. As directed in Ordering Clause 4 of the CCA Fee Order, requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 concerning newspaper publication of the proposed tariff amendments are waived.

The Company notes that Ordering Clause No. 2 requires “tariff amendments implementing Community Choice Aggregation data fees ***consistent*** (*emphasis added*) with the requirements discussed in the body of this Order and Appendix 2”. As such, since Distribution is a gas-only utility it will provide aggregated extreme peak day requirements by (Mcf) instead of aggregated peak demand (kW) and aggregated consumption (Mcf) by month instead of aggregated energy (kWh) by month. Further, to reflect a difference between the electric capacity market and gas capacity market, Distribution will provide annual peak demand information

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instead of monthly peak demand information. These changes, which are reflected on proposed Section No. – Leaf No. 0-153, align the information made available to the ESCO serving the CCA with the capacity information Distribution provides to ESCOs serving customers under traditional ESCO service.
