The amended tariff leaves set forth below are filed by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or the "Company") on July 19, 2018 to become effective July 20, 2018.

The purpose of this filing is to make a housekeeping change to clarify existing tariff language as supplemental/further revision to the RY1 compliance filing in the aforementioned case.

The amendment to Electric Leaf No. 163.5.4, General Information Section 36, Other Charges and Adjustments – Revenue Decoupling Mechanism (RDM) Adjustment is updated by adding Reactive Demand Charges to the list of components included in the definition of Active Delivery Revenue.

As the Company considers this amendment a housekeeping change with no direct impact to customers and RY1 Compliance publication is commencing, the Company requests that the requirements of §66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication for the amendments listed herein be waived.
