Dear Secretary Burgess:

In compliance with Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Public Service Commission's Order Regarding Farm-Based Distributed Energy Resources, issued and effective April 20, 2018, ("Order") in Case 15-E-0751et al., Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files the amended tariff leaves to its Schedule for Electric Service, PSC No. 15 - Electricity.

The purpose of this filing is to waive the requirement that, Community Distributed Generation (CDG) projects serving only farm operations and residences of individuals who own or are employed by the served farm operations, serve a minimum of 10 members and no single large member consume more than 40% of the credits generated by the project. The leaves are to become effective on June 1, 2018 on not less than 10 days' notice.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause No. 3 of the Order, the requirements of Section 66(12) (b) of the Public Service Law and NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication of the tariff amendments described in Ordering Clause No. 1 have been waived.
