In accordance with the *Order Adopting Terms of Joint Proposal and Establishing Electric and Gas Rate Plans* (issued and effective March 15, 2018) in Cases 17-E-0238 and 17-G-0239 (the “Order”), Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the “Company”) submits for filing the electric tariff leaf listed below.

Effective: May 24, 2018

This filing further revises the filing issued on March 28, 2018 which was made in compliance with the above Order. Specifically Rule 57.1.2.2 – Revenue Decoupling Mechanism has been revised to provide further clarification that the RDM delivery service revenue Annual Target Revenue (“ATR”) will now include NYPA (including Recharge New York “RNY”) load revenue. NYPA customers, including RNY customers, however, will not be subject to the RDM on the NYPA/RNY portion of their load.

Attachment 1 included with this filing indicates where the changes have occurred.

Waiver of newspaper publication is requested for this filing. In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 7 of the above order, the requirements of newspaper publication was completed on April 12, April 19, April 26 and May 3.
