This following tariff leaves are being submitted by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the "Company") in compliance with the New York State Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Order of February 22, 2018 in the above proceeding (the "Order").

Effective: April 1, 2018

In compliance with the Order, the Company is filing the attached tariff leaves expanding the eligibility for Value Stack compensation under the Value of Distributed Energy Resources Tariff to projects with a capacity greater than 2 MW and up to 5 MW, consistent with the directives in the body of the Order. The directed revisions have been made to Rule 40 – Value of Distributed Energy Resources (VDER).

Ordering Clause No.1 of the Order directed utilities to file tariff revisions on not less than 15 days' notice tariff to become effective April 1, 2018.

Also, in accordance with Ordering Clause No. 5, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) and (16 NYCRR §720-8.1) that require publication of tariff changes have been waived for this filing.
