The purpose of this filing is to update the Low Income Discount Program rates, remove the discount rates from the tariff and move them onto the Statement of Low Income Bill Discount Monthly Credits (LIC) and modify the eligibility to include language about enrollment in the federal Lifeline program and/or programs per the order.
