Dear Secretary Burgess:

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing 1st Revised Leaf No. 181.1 reflecting revisions to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – Electricity ("Tariff").

This leaf is issued March 22, 2017, to become effective April 1, 2017.

## Reason for Filing

The Commission's <u>Order Modifying Community Distributed Generation Membership</u> <u>Requirements</u>, issued and effective March 13, 2017, in Case 15-E-0082 (the "Order") directed each utility to file tariff amendments to remove the ten-member minimum requirement for a Community Distributed Generation ("CDG") project that serves multiple residential or nonresidential customers on its property.

## Summary of Tariff Change

As directed by the Order, the Company has revised Leaf 181.1 of Rider N – Net Metering for Customer Generators. Text on that Leaf currently indicates, "The CDG Host must designate no fewer than ten CDG Satellite Accounts." The Company has appended to that sentence, "unless all the CDG Satellite Accounts are located on the same property as the CDG Host." Received: 03/22/2017

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## Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the Company is filing this Tariff change to become effective on April 1, 2017, not less than ten days' after the Order's issuance.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Commission has waived the requirement for newspaper publication.
