Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing 2nd Revised Leaf No. 181.1 reflecting revisions to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – Electricity ("Tariff").

This leaf is issued March 24, 2017, to become effective April 1, 2017.

Background

The Commission's Order Modifying Community Distributed Generation Membership Requirements, issued and effective March 13, 2017, in Case 15-E-0082 (the "Order") directed each utility to file tariff amendments to remove the ten-member minimum requirement for a Community Distributed Generation ("CDG") project that serves multiple residential or non-residential customers on its property.

On March 22, 2017, the Company filed a change to Leaf 181.1 of Rider N – Net Metering for Customer Generators that added the text "unless all of the CDG Satellite Accounts are located on the same property as the CDG Host" to follow existing text, which stated, "The CDG Host must designate no fewer than ten CDG Satellite Accounts."

Tariff Change

At the request of Department of Public Service Staff, the Company is revising Leaf 181.1 for clarification. The text has now been revised to state, "The CDG Host must designate no fewer than ten CDG Satellite Accounts unless all of the CDG Satellite Accounts are located on

the site of the same property as the CDG Host serving residential and/or non-residential customers.”

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the Company is filing this Tariff change to become effective on April 1, 2017, not less than ten days’ after the Order’s issuance.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Commission has waived the requirement for newspaper publication.
