Purpose and Overview of Filing

The Companies are filing amendments to its tariffs in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order to remove the ten member minimum requirement for Community Distributed Generation projects that are located on the site of a property serving multiple residential or non-residential customers.
