Heritage Springs Water Works, Inc. is requesting to convert its Tariff Schedule P.S.C. No. 1 – Water to an electronic format in compliance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission of the State of New York. Tariff Schedule P.S.C. No. 1 – Water would be canceled and Tariff Schedule P.S.C. No. 2 – Water would be introduced to become effective June 1, 2016. P.S.C. No. 2 would contain Original Leaves Nos. 1 through 12 and will supersede P.S.C. No. 1.

Heritage Springs Water Works, Inc. is also proposing to add a provision to its Service Classification No. 1 Applicable to Use of Service for Residential, Commercial, and General Use; specifically the proposed provision would add rates for service through meter sizes of 1-1/2, 2, and 3 inches. Each meter size would have a minimum quarterly allowance and charge that is based on review of the existing rates in the tariffs of Hudson Valley, NY American, Rolling Meadows, United Water NY, United Water Owego/Nichols, and United Water (New Rochelle) Water Companies.

The reason for the Company's request to revise its tariff to provide service with minimum allowances and charges for meter sizes larger than 5/8 inch, is that the Company has been approached by potential commercial customers regarding service through a larger meter size. The Company would like to be prepared in advance in the event of a formal request for service.

The filing would not change the current water rate. The filing would have negligible impact on the Company's revenue or rate of return. The proposed Leaf No. 12 would add a provision for water service to customers requesting service through meter sizes larger than provided for in the current tariff. The current tariff allows service with a minimum quarterly allowance of 9,000 gallons only, the amount typically allowed for a 5/8 inch meter.
