**Purpose of Filing:**

On September 28, 2015, the Company filed tariff revisions to implement Rule 29 - Community Distributed Generation (“CDG”) pursuant to the Commission’s order, issued and effective July 17, 2015 in Case 15-E-0082. These changes were filed to become effective October 19, 2015. On October 16, 2015 the Commission issued its *Order Granting Reconsideration in Part* in the same proceeding extending the effective date of the tariff leaves filed on September 28, 2015 to October 26, 2015. The October 16, 2015 Order also directed the utilities to make further tariff changes.

The above leaves incorporate the changes directed in the Order which include:

- 1) The implementation of the change to the credit allocation methodology
- 2) Modifies the tariff to indicate that the CDG Host’s initial and annual self certification requirement must be submitted to the Company, not the Commission or the Department of Public Service Staff.
- 3) The references to the CDG Operating Procedures have been revised to change the name of the document to CDG Program Procedural Requirements to more accurately reflect its actual function.
- 4) Other minor housekeeping revisions have been included with this filing.

For ease of Staff review of the proposed changes, Attachment 1 has been included with this filing indicating where the changes have occurred.
