On June 29, 2015 the Company issued a filing in compliance with the above Order replacing monetary crediting with volumetric crediting at remote net metered sites where non-demand rates are in effect. The purpose of this filing is to make revisions to the filing made on June 29, 2015 to further clarify how non-demand remote net metered customers will be billed and their satellites will be credited for excess generation under non-demand rates.
