**Re: Case 19-G-0310 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of KeySpan Gas East Corp. d/b/a National Grid for Gas Service.**

Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with the *Order Approving Joint Proposal, as Modified, and Imposing Additional Requirements* (issued and effective August 12, 2021) in Case 19-G-0310 (the “Order”), KeySpan Gas East Corp. d/b/a National Grid (the “Company”) submits for filing the gas tariff leaves and statements listed on Attachment A hereto. Specifically, Ordering Clause No. 7 of the Order directed the Company to file, on not less than 30 days’ notice, tariff revisions to effectuate the provisions adopted by the Order for Stayout Period to take effect on a temporary basis on April 1, 2023. The Company is also filing as Attachment B the unit rate calculation for the Rate Adjustment Clause (“RAC”), to take effect as of April 1, 2023.

In addition, the Company is also including housekeeping tariff leaves related to the address change from One MetroTech Center, Brooklyn, New York 11201 to 2 Hanson Place, Brooklyn, New York 11217, and the inclusion of SC17 that has been inadvertently excluded from the applicable service class listing as shown on Leaf 74.1 under the Research & Development section.

Per Ordering Clause No. 8 of the Order and as required by Public Service Law § 66-12 and 16 NYCRR § 720-8.1, the changes set forth in the revised tariff leaves for Stayout Period will be published in newspapers in the Company’s service territory. The Company will file proof of publication with the Commission once all publications have been made.

This filing is made in accordance with Appendix 7-H (electronic filing system) to the Commission’s Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR, Appendix 7-H). As required by the Order, the active parties to Case 19-G-0310 have been copied on this filing.
