Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the "Company") is filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the "Electric Tariff"), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The revised Electric Tariff leaf identified below is filed to become effective on February 2, 2024:

## **Reason for Filing**

On January 18, 2024, the Company made a filing in compliance with the Commission's *Order Implementing Immediate Solutions Programs*, issued and effective November 20, 2023, in Case 22-E-0236 (the "Order"). The Order directed the Company to file tariff amendments consistent with the draft tariff leaves submitted in the Company's March 20, 2023 Implementation Plan, as modified consistent with the Order.

Since the January 18, 2024 filing, the Company discovered that further tariff changes are needed to eliminate the medium and heavy duty vehicle incentive under the Managed Charging Participation Program, since the Order approved the Company's March 20, 2023 Implementation Plan, which included the proposed change.

## **Tariff Changes**

Pursuant to the Order, the Company has deleted the provision for medium and heavy duty vehicle incentives in General Rule 10.12, Electric Vehicle Managed Charging Program Participation Incentives, of the Electric Tariff. In addition, the Company is filing the Statement

of Managed Charging Participation Incentives – MCPI Statement No. 2, to remove the medium and heavy duty vehicles incentive.

## **Conclusion and Notice**

Consistent with Ordering Clause 4 of the Order, the Company is filing changes to the Electric Tariff on not less than one day's notice to become effective on February 2, 2024. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 12 of the Order, the Commission waived the requirement for newspaper publication of these changes and this further revision is in compliance with the Order.
