The Joint Proposal for Rate Plan Modification in Case 00-E-1273, as approved in the aforementioned Order, provided for an additional pre-tax refund of \$5 million, or after-tax refund of \$3 million, for residential (Service Classification Nos. 1 and 6) and commercial (Service Classification No. 2) customers over the period July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, to be dispersed under the existing refund mechanism.

The revised Customer Refund Factor included on Statement of Customer Refund CR-6 was developed by allocating the pre-tax refund of \$5 million equally over the forecasted billing units for service provided to the applicable service classifications for the period July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005. As a result, the Customer Refund Factor is the same for all applicable Service Classifications and will be applied as a per kWh credit to the energy (kWh) deliveries on the

bills of all full service and delivery service customers served under Service Classification Nos. 1, 2 and 6 of this Schedule.

As directed by Ordering Paragraph One of the Order, copies of the amendments and statement were sent to all active parties in this proceeding.

Also as directed in Ordering Paragraph One of the Order, the requirements of $\S66(12)(b)$ of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication have been waived.
