Water Supply Enhancement Surcharge Statement No.2

William K. Green (the Company) is authorized to establish a Water Supply Enhancement (WSE) surcharge for the purpose of recovering \$16,259, at 6% interest, in extraordinary expenses it incurred in 2014 to rehabilitate its well supplies, install a new treatment system, and construct a new treatment building, to satisfy requirements by the Orange County Department of Health.

The WSE surcharge is subject to the following conditions:

1. The WSE surcharge will be collected quarterly from all customers commencing with the first billing period after the effective date of this statement in the amounts shown in the table below, and will continue to be collected until a total of twenty (20) consecutive collections are made.

<u>Customer Type</u>	<u>Quarterly Surcharge</u>
one-family house	\$62.72
two-family house	\$81.54
three-family house	\$100.33
five-family house	\$137.95
auto body repair shop	\$62.72

2. The Company will have access to the funds immediately upon receipt solely for the purposes noted above.
3. The WSE surcharge collection will cease after customers are billed the twentieth consecutive WSE surcharge.
4. Customers terminating service will not be entitled to a refund of WSE surcharge payments made.
5. The Company shall submit an accounting of its annual surcharge collections at the request of the Chief of the Gas & Water Rates Section, Office of Electric Gas & Water, Department of Public Service.
