NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE MAKING**

ATTACHMENT TO DRAFT NOTICE

Proposed action: The New York State Public Service Commission (“Commission”) is considering whether to approve or reject, in whole or in part, proposed tariff revisions to tariff schedules PSC No. 90 – Gas Service filed by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (“NYSEG”) and PSC No. 16 – Gas Service filed by Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (“RG&E”) (together the “Companies”), to become effective on July 1, 2022.

Subject of rule: Proposed revisions to tariff schedules.

Purpose of rule: The Companies are filing revisions to their respective tariffs to eliminate the outdated provisions prohibiting the use of natural gas for decorative outdoor lighting.

Substance of proposed rule: The New York State Public Service Commission is considering whether to approve or reject, in whole or in part, proposed tariff revisions submitted by NYSEG and RG&E to eliminate the outdated provisions prohibiting the use of natural gas for decorative outdoor lighting.
