Please find attached the letter from the Village Attorney for the Village of Bath in connection with the payroll error discussed in the Commission's most recent Bath Rate Order (Case 09-E-0201, Order Issued and Effective August 21, 2009, at pp. 14-15). The Commission's Order provides that "... the Village of Bath be authorized to defer any salary adjustments made as a result of the investigation;" (Order, p. 16, \P 5). The Village Attorney advises that the overpayments were repaid, and the matter closed. There were no "salary adjustments made as a result of the investigation." Also, as noted in the Commission's Order, *supra*, the overpayments were not reflected in the revenue requirement. Therefore, we believe no deferral is warranted under the express terms of the Order.
