Dear Mr. Gennari;
In Case 04-W-1221, the Commission allowed UWNR to spend up to $\$ 2.5$ million per year on LTMR work with a cumulative $\$ 8.0$ million cap over the four year term of the rate plan. The rate plan allows the company to recover its LTMRP expenditures through a surcharge, subject to verification by Staff.

On October 19, 2006 the company provided documentation to support project expenditures of $\$ 0.494$ million and calculated that if "approved", as filed, the resultant LTMRP surcharge would be increased from $1.28 \%$ to $1.59 \%$. The specific projects covered under the instant request included the installation and replacement of approximately 1,200 feet of old main on Cliff Road in the UWNR service area. Work for these projects was completed in the Spring of 2006 .

Staff reviewed the company's filing including the vendor invoices and the method for calculating the surcharge amount and found it to be in compliance with the specific LTMRP surcharge requirements. As a result the company may increase the LTMRP surcharge to $1.59 \%$ starting with the December 7, 2006 billing cycle, as requested. Finally, it should also be noted that LTMRP surcharges are subject to an annual audit and reconciliation.
