Upon the Corporation's determination that the customer has taken service under this Section while in violation of the conditions of service set forth herein, the customer shall forfeit any positive balance accrued during the annual period in which the violation occurred.

Pursuant to the Standard Interconnection Requirements set forth within Addendum-SIR of PSC No.119, customers are responsible for providing all meter boxes and sockets. In the event that NYSEG determines that it is necessary to install a dedicated transformer or transformers, or other equipment to protect the safety and adequacy of electric service provided to other customers, a customer generator with a rating less than 25 kW shall pay for the cost of installing such transformer(s) or other equipment, up to a maximum amount of \$350. A customer-generator with a combined rating equal to or greater than 25 kW shall pay for the cost of installing the transformer(s), or other equipment. Notwithstanding the provisions herein, non-residential fuel cell electric customers are responsible for meeting all otherwise applicable provisions and requirements of PSC. Nos. 119 and 120.
