## RIDER J

## NYPA - POWER FOR JOBS (PFJ) RIDER

Any customer who is qualified to take service under Service Classification No. 2, 3, 9, 20, 21, 22, or eligible customers taking service under Service Classification No. 25 of this Schedule, and meets the following eligibility criteria shall be eligible to take and pay for PFJ Service under this Rider.

- (A) Customer must be approved by the New York State Economic Development Power Allocation Board (Board) to receive a firm allocation of power under the New York Power Authority's (NYPA) Power for Jobs Program as provided in Article 6 of the New York State Economic Development Law and Section 1005 of the Public Authorities Law.
- (B) Customer must complete an Application for Service and supply to the Company a copy of the signed contract or service agreement between the customer and NYPA setting forth the terms and provisions for service under the PFJ Program. If, at any time during the term of the contract or service agreement, any of its provisions are amended, the customer shall supply to the Company, within ten days of its effective date, a copy of such amendment, contract, or new service agreement.
- (C) A Customer receiving an allocation of power and energy under phase five of the Power for Jobs Program may elect the "Energy service company option" under Article 6 of the New York State Economic Development Law and Section 1005 of the Public Authorities Law. Such election shall transfer the allocation to the customer's ESCO for resale to the customer in accordance with the above laws.
- (D) Service under this Rider shall not be available in conjunction with service under the Company's Economic Development Service Rider Rider H.
- (E) The Company shall have no responsibility for ensuring that a customer's bill for service hereunder will be less than or equal to the amount the Company would charge if full service were provided by the Company.
