MONTHLY CHARGES & CREDITS:

Basic Service Charge:

A basic monthly service charge equivalent to 125% of the Service Classification basic service charge shall be billed to the Customer regardless of energy usage in lieu of the basic service charge normally applicable to the Service Classification.

Energy Charge:

Charges to Customer:

The Customer will pay the rates and charges for the Customer's applicable Service Classification for net energy supplied.

- Credits to Customer:
 - If a Customer produces more energy than consumed during an individual billing cycle, a kWh credit will be carried forward until consumed, or the end of the calendar year, as described below.
 - If a Customer produces more energy than consumed during any calendar year, the Customer will receive a money credit following the first billing cycle that ends on or after the last day of each calendar year. The credit will be calculated by multiplying the kWh credit balance times the average of the Average Cost of Fuel from the JBPU's monthly Statements of Fuel Adjustment Cost filed during the past 12 months, adjusted by the Factor of Adjustment. Upon payment of the credit, the kWh credit balance shall be reset to zero.
