14. Competitive Metering Option: (Cont'd.)

(b) Customer Qualification

Qualified Customers whose entire or partial load is served under any of NYSEG's economic development incentive rates (ERI, IDI, EDI, EDZI or ILI) and who select the Competitive Metering Option must elect the Competitive Metering Option on their entire load. Similarly, Qualified Customers who receive a portion of their Electric Power Supply from NYPA (Expansion, Replacement Power, EDP, HLFM, PFJ, Preservation Power, and Recharge NY Power) and who select the Competitive Metering Option must elect the Competitive Metering Option on their entire load.

Customers whose entire load is served under NYSEG's S.C. 13 or S.C. 14 contracts may be eligible for the Competitive Metering Option after their contracts expire, unless their contracts with NYSEG permit such customer to become eligible earlier.

(c) Competitive Metering Charges

Qualified Customers who obtain competitive metering service(s) from an MSP/MDSP which has met the PSC's eligibility requirements for competitive metering will not be charged the Meter Ownership, Meter Service and/or Meter Data Service Charge for the specific service(s) provided by the competitive metering provider.
