RIDER U - DISTRIBUTION LOAD RELIEF PROGRAM - Continued

F. Interconnection and Delivery for Load Delivery Customers

The Company reserves the right to exclude a generator from connecting to the Company's distribution system when the Company deems it necessary to protect its system, facilities, or other Customers. In addition, the Company may prohibit a Customer from delivering power and energy to the Company's distribution system, or limit the amount of power and energy delivered, for operational reasons.

Except for those served under Rider R, a Customer who contracts, or a customer of an Aggregator who contracts, to provide Load Delivery must comply with all Common Provisions of SC 11, including the Interconnection Charge and Determination of Demand, including establishment of a contract demand and installation of appropriate metering to measure the energy delivered to the Company's system. Further, such Customer is required to pay charges as would be required of Customers taking service under Service Classification No. 11. The Customer will pay any costs associated with reinforcing the distribution system and/or adding facilities as may be required for Load Delivery.
