## Reserve Requirements (Cont'd.)

(C) Other interruptible customers must maintain reserve levels acceptable to the Company.

A customer with an inadequate alternate fuel reserve that fails to interrupt gas service at any time during the first 10 days of interruption in any Winter Period or who has inadequate alternate fuel reserve as of November 1 of each year shall be subject to the Charge for Inoperable Alternate Fuel/Energy Facilities or Inadequate Fuel Reserves set forth in Special Provision F (3) of this Service Classification.

To the extent required by the <u>Order Directing Utilities to File Revised Interruptible Gas Service Tariffs</u>, issued and effective August 24, 2000, in Case 00-G-0996, the Company will consider, on a case-by-case basis, requests to be exempt from the applicable reserve requirement from individual customers that elect to shut down operations during interruption periods for as long as gas service is interrupted, where the customer agrees to (i) install or to have installed, all equipment (including an automatic shut-off valve and communications equipment) deemed necessary by the Company, at customer's sole cost and expense, (ii) reimburse the Company for any other costs incurred by the Company in connection with such election and its implementation, and (iii) execute all documents deemed necessary by the Company to consider such election as verifiable.

## (F) Provisions Relating Interruptions

## (1)Failure to Interrupt

Customers that fail to fully interrupt their use of gas for any two interruption periods (including any Company announced planned interruptions)("two-violation rule") during each Winter Period will thereafter be ineligible for service hereunder and will be transferred to Service Classification No. 1, 2, or 6, whichever is applicable, commencing with the first billing month following the month in which the second violation occurs, unless the Company has received written notification requesting that the service be disconnected and the Company has verified that that it has been disconnected and locked.
