### SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 5

### SEASONAL GAS COOLING SERVICE

#### APPLICABLE TO THE USE OF SERVICE FOR:

General gas service to non-residential customers (also taking service under another service classification) exclusively for natural gas cooling or desiccant dehumidifying equipment. Service hereunder is only available during the period May through September of each year.

#### CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Continuous - natural gas or a mixture of natural gas and synthetic natural gas with a Btu content of not less than 975 Btu per cubic foot for the Lockport Area, not less than 950 Btu per cubic foot for the Champlain Area, and not less than 1,000 Btu per cubic foot for all other areas. Normal pressure 7" but not less than 4" water column. At the option of the Company, gas will be supplied at high pressure, where such service is available.
