In addition to the above delivery service charges, all customers taking service under this service classification shall be subject to a System Benefits Charge as explained in General Information Rule 31

**DELIVERY SERVICE ADJUSTMENTS:**

All customers taking service under this Service Classification shall be subject to a Pipeline Refund as explained in General Information Rule No. 17.6.2.1 and a Research and Development Surcharge as explained in General Information Rule No.30.

**STATEMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RATES:**

All surcharges or refunds applicable to billings for Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 5, 7, and 8 will be duly filed with the Public Service Commission apart from this rate schedule, not less than three (3) days prior to the first of each month. Such statement will be available to the public at the Company's offices at which application for service may be made.

**INCREASE IN RATES AND CHARGES:**

The rate and charges under this Service Classification will be increased by a tax factor pursuant to Rule 19.

**TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

Bills are due and payable. Full payment must be received on or before the date shown on the bill to avoid a late payment charge of one and one-half percent (1 1/2%).

**TERM:**

One year initially and renewable on a year-to-year basis thereafter. Cancellation requires written notice by the Company or customer thirty days prior to the expiration of the annual term of service.
