- (d) In the case of a disputed account involving the accuracy of a meter, such meter will be tested by the Company upon the request of the Customer. There will be no charge for testing of the meter. However, all subsequent meter tests performed within one year of the free meter test will be subject to the charge stipulated in service classification No.7 of this tariff.
- (e) The test of the meter requested by the Customer may be witnessed by the Customer or his duly authorized representative.

NON-REGISTERING METERS:

- (f) The reading of a duly installed meter showing the amount of water consumed shall be used for all metered billing purposes except where it appears that the meter has ceased to register or has registered inaccurately.
- (g) In all cases where a meter is found to be defective, it shall be immediately replaced by a meter that has been tested and properly adjusted.
- (h) In cases where it is found that a meter has ceased to register or has registered inaccurately and it cannot be determined by reasonable test the percentage of inaccuracy, an estimated bill for the billing period immediately preceding the date when such meter was found defective and for the period from said date to the date of replacement of the meter, may be rendered the Customer but the right to render an estimated bill is strictly limited to such periods and for all other periods the bill shall be the minimum rate provided in the applicable rate schedule. The estimated bill shall be based upon the amount of water consumed in the corresponding period in prior years, except where it appears that there has been a change in the occupancy of the premises or in the use of water, in which case an equitable adjustment shall be made.

19. PRIVATE FIRE SERVICE CONNECTIONS:

- (a) All applications for private fire service connections shall be made in writing on applications forms provided by the Company, the wording of which is given on Leaf No. 68-69.
- (b) The size of the private fire service connection shall be determined by the Company and in no case shall exceed six (6) inches.
