AGGREGATED POOL**

When a Pool is comprised of Customers taking Non-Core Transportation (NCT) Service under S.C. No. 18, each Customer of the Pool shall pay all applicable rates and charges under S.C. No. 18, except for the following rates and charges which shall be the responsibility of the Seller:

**Monthly Balancing Charges**

The Company shall balance the Seller's Pool at the end of each month to zero. This shall be done by comparing the sum of the Seller's deliveries for the month to the Pool's actual usage for the same period.

If the Seller delivered more gas to the Company for its Pool than the Pool consumed, the excess shall be purchased by the Company at the Company's Monthly Average Commodity Cost of Gas for the same period. If the Seller's Pool consumed more gas than delivered to the Company for its Pool, the excess shall be deemed purchased by the Seller at the Company's Actual Monthly ICOG for the same period, and shall be reflected as a charge on the Seller's next monthly invoice.

**City Gate Balancing**

Customer shall be responsible for delivery each day to the Company of a quantity of gas equal to the ADDQ.

- A) Each day, Seller shall nominate and schedule deliveries of gas to the Company in an amount equal to the Seller's ADDQ. If the total quantity of gas delivered by Seller to the Company on any day is within  $\pm 2\%$  of Seller's ADDQ for such day, and Customer has met its nomination and scheduling obligations hereunder then,
