When a Capacity Release Seller serving Firm Transportation Customers taking Daily Delivery Service, has taken less than the sum of the MDQs of its Firm Transportation Customers, in addition to the requirements specified above, the Capacity Release Seller shall present documentation to the Company (in accordance with the requirements set forth in the GTOP) by the first business day in October, that there is in place one or more executed transportation contract(s) with one or more interstate pipeline(s) for transportation or storage and associated transportation to the Citygate dedicated to deliveries for the Customers account for the Winter Period for the difference between the highest anticipated Daily Load Quantity the Customer is required to deliver and the daily quantities specified in the foregoing paragraphs. The highest anticipated Daily Load Quantity shall be determined by the Company on the basis of the Customer's historical usage and design weather conditions. Such transportation and storage must be non-recallable firm with primary delivery point capacity from the source of gas supply to the Citygate.

Seller's demonstration of firm transportation requirements shall include submission of a completed Con Edison Affidavit of Firm Transportation and other supporting documentation as set forth in subsection (A) (2) of the Character of Service section of Service Classification No. 9.

In instances where the Capacity Release Seller's load increases during the Winter Period, and such increases will not be served with capacity provided by the Company, pursuant to this Capacity Release Service, the Capacity Release Seller must comply with the documentation requirements set forth above by the first day of the calendar month following such increase.
