GENERAL INFORMATION

14. DISCONTINUANCE OF WATER SERVICE – NONRESIDENTIAL:

Water service may be discontinued for any one of the following reasons:

- A. For use of water other than represented in application or through branch connections on the street side of the meter or place reserved therefore.
- B. For molesting any service pipe, seal, meter, or any other appliance owned by the Company.
- C. For nonpayment of bills for water or services rendered by the Company in accord with this tariff.
- D. For cross-connecting pipes carrying water supplied by the Company with any other source of supply or with any apparatus which may endanger the quality of the Company's water supply.
- E. For refusal of reasonable access to the property for the purposes of inspecting fixtures or piping or for reading, repairing, testing or removing meters.
- F. For violation of the rules of the Company as filed with the Public Service Commission.
- G. For submetering or reselling water.
- H. For willful waste or use of water through improper or imperfect pipes or by any other means.

14.1 TERMINATION OF RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

- A. Water Service may be discontinued by the Company for any one of the following reasons:
 - 1. Failing to pay any tariff charges that reflect service used during the preceding 12 months, for which a written bill has been given;
 - 2. Failing to pay any tariff charges that reflect service used before the preceding 12 months, for which a written bill has been sent, when any of the following occurs:
 - (a) There was a billing dispute during the preceding 12 months;
 - (b) There was an excusable Company delay;
