Inspection of Other's Meters:

Seller and Buyer shall have access to the measuring equipment of the other used in measuring or checking the measurement of deliveries of gas old at any time upon demand for the purpose of inspection. The Buyer at all reasonable times may have tests or calibrations made of Seller's meters at Buyer's own expense, and in the present of Seller's representatives and Seller shall have the same right with respect to Buyer's check measuring equipment.

Correction of Metering Errors:

If, upon test, any metering equipment is found to be inaccurate by two percent, or more, correction for inaccuracies and adjustment therefore shall be made for such period as may be definitely known and agreed upon; or if not known and agreed upon, for one-half of the period elapsed since the last date of calibration.

Failure of Meters:

In the event that any Seller's meters measuring gas delivered to Buyer becomes inoperative, or manifestly in error, then the quantity of gas delivered during the period that such meter was inoperative or manifestly in error shall be determined by any one of the following methods which shall be feasible.

- (a) By correcting the error if ascertainable by calibration test or mathematical calculation.
- (b) By using the registration of Buyer's check meter if installed and accurately registering.
- (c) By estimating the quantity delivered upon the basis of deliveries during preceding periods under similar conditions when the meter was registering accurately.

10. Billing and Payment:

Billing:

On or before the 10th day of each calendar month, Seller shall render to buyer a detailed statement showing the volumes of gas sold to the Buyer during the preceding monthly period and the amount due and payable therefore.
