Market Price Charge and Market Price Adjustment

Said charges will be applied each month to the kilowatthours determined in the manner set forth hereunder. Customers participating in the Retail Access Program as described in General Information Section 35 shall not be subject to these charges.

MERCHANT FUNCTION CHARGE

The Merchant Function Charge, as described in General Information Section 36.E, shall apply to all electricity delivered under this Service Classification. For billing purposes, the Merchant Function Charge will be included in the Miscellaneous Charges.

The System Benefits Charge, Renewable Portfolio Standard Charge, Customer Refund and applicable portions of the Energy Cost Adjustment Mechanism and Merchant Function Charge will apply to the kWh determined in the following manner:

kWh = (Total Wattage ÷ 1,000) x (Monthly Burning Hours*)
