This Non-Retail Access choice includes fixed charges for NYSEG delivery service, a fluctuating Transition Charge (Non-Bypassable Charge [NBC]), a commodity charge for electricity supplied by NYSEG that fluctuates with the market price of electricity, and a merchant function charge.
