(2) <u>Monthly Minimum Charge</u>

Customers served under this Rider will be subject to a Monthly Minimum Charge, determined in the manner set forth below. Billing of such Monthly Minimum Charge shall commence with the fourth monthly billing period for service hereunder.

For customers served under Rate Schedule I of this Rider, the Monthly Minimum Charge during the first annual period during which the charge is applicable shall be determined by applying the Rate Schedule I Usage Charge to a usage level of one-half of the product of the Peak Day Gas Usage that was used to determine the customer's initial eligibility for service hereunder and the number of days in the billing period. For each annual period thereafter, the Monthly Minimum Charge shall be determined by applying the Rate Schedule I Usage Charge to a usage level of onehalf of the product of the Peak Day Gas Usage in the prior determination period used to determine continued eligibility under this Rider and the number of days in the billing period. For customers served under Rate Schedule II of this Rider, the Monthly Minimum Charge shall be (1) the Contract Demand Charge plus (2) a usage charge, determined by applying the Rate Schedule II Usage Charge to a usage level of one-half of the product of the customer's Contract Demand times twenty-four hours and the number of days in the billing period.

The Monthly Minimum Charges billed under this Rider shall be subject to an annual reconciliation at twelve-month intervals following the date that the customer is first subject to the Monthly Minimum Charge. If the customer's Annual Load Factor for the annual reconciliation period is equal to or
