GENERAL INFORMATION

9. Distributed Generation Interconnection Requirements (Cont'd.)

C. DG Standardized Contract:

- (1) Customer is required to enter into a signed Contract with NYSEG substantially in the form of, New York State Standardized Contract for Interconnection of Distributed Generation Units with Capacity of 300 kVA or less to be Connected in Parallel with Radial Distribution Lines, which is included in Section G below.
- (2) Termination of the Contract by either party will be in accordance with the Contract section 1.2 Termination.

D. DG Interconnection Requirements:

- (1) DG Interconnection Requirements will be in accordance with the relevant sections of NYSEG's Requirements for Independent Power Producers of Electricity pertaining to the New York State Standardized Interconnection Requirements for Distribution Generators Rated 300 kVA or Less, Connected in Parallel with Radial Distribution Lines. These Standard Interconnect Requirements are identical to the appendix to the Commission's Order Denying Petitions for Rehearing, Providing Clarifications, Modifying Standard Interconnection Requirements, and Directing Filing of Revised Tariffs, Case 94-E-0952, issued November 15, 2000, and Order Modifying Standard Interconnection Requirements, Case 02-E-1282, issued November 6, 2002.

E. DG Customer Charges:

- (1) For units over 15 kVA, a \$350 application fee will be required to be paid with the completed application.
- (2) For units of 15 kVA and less, no application fee is required.
- (3) For all units 300 kVA and less, the Customer will be responsible for an advance payment for NYSEG's estimated costs associated with engineering review, system modifications, metering, and on-site verification.
- (4) The Application fee, if required, and any advance payment will be applied against NYSEG's total cost of interconnection which will be reconciled after final acceptance of the unit. The Customer will receive either a bill for any balance due or a reimbursement for overpayment as determined by the Company's reconciliation.

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
