  - c) <u>Waivers (Cont'd)</u>
    - (ii) The Distribution Provider, if the Distribution Customer or its Retail Customer can establish through two estimates, one of which may be a Distribution Provider audit, that the purchase price and installation charge (excluding financing charges) will be greater than seven times the anticipated annual savings to be obtained, (based on the present cost of the fuel currently used in the dwelling).
    - (iii) The Public Service Commission for just cause, in unusual circumstances, if the Distribution Customer or its Retail Customer has been denied a waiver pursuant to subsections (i) or (ii), above.

A copy of each variance granted or denied by the Distribution Provider shall be made available to the Commission, and each applicant denied a variance shall be promptly informed by the Distribution Provider of the right to appeal to the Commission.

d) <u>Certificate of Compliance</u>

A Certificate of Compliance (see Rule 12.D) shall be used in all areas of the state where no local authority exists, to assure compliance with the insulation requirements of the Energy Conservation Construction Code.

Each Certificate of Compliance shall be signed by the builder or contractor and the owner shall receive a copy of such certificate
