D. EXTENSION AND MAINTENANCE OF DISTRIBUTION PROVIDER FACILITIES (Cont'd)

(3) Distribution Customer Obligations - Street Lighting (Cont'd)

(g) The Distribution Customer shall notify the Distribution Provider in writing, fifteen (15) business days prior to the completed installation of equipment, the number of units to be installed, the size, light source, burning hours and wattage of each lamp type. Where applicable, wattage rating shall include load impressed by associated ballast.

The Distribution Customer may designate a contact person to perform any of the obligations set forth in this Rule 10.D.3 for a given Retail Customer, with the exception of payment obligations, which will be solely the obligation of the Distribution Customer. Such designation must be in writing, and any actions taken by the designated contact person in regard to this Rule 10.D.3 shall be considered to have been taken by the Distribution Customer.

The provisions for extension and maintenance of Distribution Provider facilities set forth in Rule 6 of this Tariff are not applicable to street lighting and/or traffic signal service points.
