1. DEFINITIONS AND ABBREVIATIONS (Cont'd)

Retail Customer's Premise: Discrete contiguous real property under the Retail Customer's control through ownership or lease.

Retail Gas Tariff: The Distribution Provider's P.S.C. No. 16 Schedule for Gas Service.

Rollover: The settlement of monthly imbalances in a subsequent month by modifying gas deliveries to eliminate the deficiency or surplus.

Seasons:

Summer: May 1 - October 31, inclusive Winter: November 1 - April 30, inclusive

Service Line: The piping, including associated metering and pressure reducing appurtenances, that transports gas below grade from a main to the first accessible fitting inside the wall of a customer's building when the meter is located within the building; if a meter is located outside the building, the service line will be deemed to terminate at the outside of the building foundation wall.

Service Point: The Service Point shall normally be at the connection point between the Distribution Provider's Service Line and the Retail Customer's or Distribution Customer's facilities; or, if the Service Line is not owned by the Distribution Provider, the Service Point is the connection point of the Distribution Provider's Distribution System to the Retail Customer's Service Line.

Service-Point-Related Charges: Charges for Distribution Provider services for which the price is calculated based on the number of Service Points or therms of gas consumed.
