## 10. STREET LIGHTING (Cont'd)

# B. RETAIL CUSTOMER ENROLLMENT (Cont'd)

### (1) New Service Points (Cont'd)

The minimum area specified in (a) above, shall include both sides of the street, road, alley, way or highway (but shall be measured only along one side), and, in non-rural areas, shall begin and terminate at intersections. A street which is either only one block long from beginning to end, or a dead-end street from intersection to its end, shall meet the minimum area requirements, regardless of length. As used herein, "intersection" may include any adjacent corners.

For purposes of (b) and (c) above, parcels intersected by a public street or highway, by a railroad right of way, or by a river, shall not be deemed to be contiguous, and will be considered two separate parcels.

#### (2) Existing Service Points

### (a) Existing Retail Customer at an Existing Service Point

To request a transfer of an existing Retail Customer at an existing street lighting or traffic signal service point(s) from the Distribution Provider's retail service to a Distribution Customer's service or from one Distribution Customer's service to another, the Distribution Customer must submit a signed, written application containing the information specified in the Distribution Customer Manual to the Distribution Provider. The Distribution Provider and the Distribution Customer will negotiate the time frame required for the transfer, based on the number and complexity of service points being transferred. No transfer will be made within thirty (30) calendar days of the last transfer of that service point(s).

For existing service points, the Distribution Customer must contact the Distribution Provider for service point identification.
