L.2 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ZONE (Cont'd)

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Continuous, Alternating Current - 60 cycle, voltage and phase at the Company's option, as available and appropriate for the customer's requirement.

BILLING AND PROGRAM BENEFITS

The Company will calculate bills for service supplied under the Economic Development Zone Rider in accordance with the applicable Special Provision under Service Classification Nos. 2, 3, 7, 8 or 9.

ENERGY AUDIT

The Company will provide the customer with an energy audit of their facility within six months of obtaining service under this rate, or provide assistance through its New Construction Design Program for new facilities, or accept a recent energy audit performed by the customer. The purpose of the audit is to identify potential cost-effective, energy saving opportunities at the customer's facility. The Company will work with the customer in an attempt to develop a plan for installation of recommended cost-effective measures, and help to identify financing opportunities either through RG&E's existing DSM programs or from other sources.

INCREASE IN RATES AND CHARGES

The rates and charges under this rider, including any adjustments, are increased by the applicable effective aggregate percentage shown in Rule 4.I for service supplied the municipality where the customer is taking service.
