Fees for Suspension of Service:

NYSEG will be compensated by the Marketer for costs associated with suspension of delivery services at the following rates:

\$62.00 per visit to the customer's location for attempted or completed physical termination at the customer's meter.

And an additional \$72.00 if physical termination is required at the existing curb valve.

If a physical termination is being made simultaneously on behalf of both NYSEG and the Marketer, the Marketer will be charged one-half of the otherwise applicable fee set forth above.

Suspension shall end upon the occurrence of any of the following conditions:

- (a) Upon the occurrence of any of the conditions identified in paragraphs (a)-(e) of Subdivision 1 of Section 35 of Public Service Law,
- (b) upon the expiration of one year after such termination of commodity service,
- (c) upon the receipt of payments by or on behalf of the customer to the Marketer such that the amount paid by such customer to the Marketer plus the amount previously paid the Marketer plus any other charges paid to NYSEG during the period when such customer's arrears accrued is equal to or greater than the amount such customer would have paid if the entire utility service had been obtained from NYSEG during such period.
