Not less than three working days prior to the first day of each billing period, the Company shall file with the Commission a statement showing the Maximum Allowable Unit Charge, the Minimum Allowable Unit Charge, the actual Unit Charges to be billed, the Difference and the Effective Charges as provided for above.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

None.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Bills are due when rendered, subject to a late payment charge in accordance with the provisions of General Information Section 6.6.

TERM:

One year and successive annual periods thereafter until terminated by the customer at the end of any contract year upon not less than ninety (90) days prior notice in writing to the Company; terminable by the Company upon like notice to the customer; also terminable by the Company in the manner provided by law and provisions of this rate schedule.

In addition to all other remedies available to the Company, the Company reserves the right to discontinue service immediately, temporarily or permanently, to the customer or to the premises where there is a violation or any failure to comply with any of the provisions of this Service Classification, the Company's Sales and Transportation Operating Procedures, or this Rate Schedule.
