**SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 8 (Cont'd.)**

**SPECIAL PROVISIONS: (Cont'd.)**

(I) New Interruptible Customer Load Requirements

Customers commencing service under this Service Classification on and after November 1, 2004, must, in addition to the other requirements of this Service Classification, meet and maintain certain minimum usage requirements in order to be eligible for service hereunder. To be eligible for service hereunder, a customer must use a minimum of 100,000 Ccf of gas per year and must have a minimum Peak Demand of 100 Ccf of gas during the period November through March (hereinafter referred to as the "Minimum Usage Requirements"). For the purpose of this provision, Peak Demand is defined as the highest one-hour gas usage during the preceding period November through March.

Unless the Company possesses sufficient usage history to determine eligibility for service under this Service Classification, the customer shall provide the Company with a reasonable estimate of customer's Peak Demand and annual usage. Such estimate shall be submitted on a form provided by the Company that is completed and signed by a Professional Engineer retained by the customer. In the event a customer does not provide the Company with the required information to determine the customer's eligibility for service hereunder, the Company will attempt to estimate the customer's Peak Demand and annual usage using the best available information. A customer may be denied service under this Service Classification if the customer fails to supply the information required to determine initial eligibility.

Each April, the Company shall review the usage history, for the 12 billing months ending the preceding March, of customers taking service under this Service Classification on and after November 1, 2004 to determine continued eligibility for service under this Service Classification. Customer's that fail to meet the Minimum Usage Requirements will be ineligible for service under this Service Classification and will be transferred to and billed at the otherwise appropriate Service Classification of this Rate Schedule. In instances where the customer can demonstrate to the Company's satisfaction that the customer experienced conditions that prevented the customer from meeting the Minimum Usage Requirements and that such conditions were beyond the customer's control, the Company may, at its sole discretion, continue to allow the customer to take service under this Service Classification. Customers ineligible for service under this Service Classification for failing to maintain the Minimum Usage Requirements will be ineligible for service under this Service Classification for a period of twelve months.
