All kilowatt hours, per kWh

ELECTRIC SUPPLY RECONCILIATION MECHANISM (ESR, ALSO CALLED SUPPLY COST  
ADJUSTMENT):  
Per ESR Statement, as described in Rule 4  
All kilowatt hours, per kWh

##### **INCREASE IN RATES AND CHARGES :**

The monthly charge under this Service Classification, shall be increased by the applicable effective aggregate percentage shown in Rule 4.5 for service supplied within the municipality where the customer is taking service.

##### **SYSTEM BENEFITS CHARGE:**

The rates and charges under this Service Classification are increased by the applicable system benefits charge, as mandated by Public Service Commission Order issued January 26 2001, shown in the System Benefits Charge Statement.

##### **MONTHLY CHARGE:**

The monthly charge shall be 1/12 the sum of the lamp, fixture and circuit charges for units in service at the beginning of the month, plus or minus the pro rata charge for lamps, fixtures and circuits installed or removed for periods greater or less than a month.

##### **TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

All bills are rendered at the above rate. A late payment charge of one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) per month shall become due and payable if payment is not made on or before the "last day to pay" date specified on the bill in accordance with the provisions of Rule 4.2.
